PARTICIPATION WAIVER & LIABILITY RELEASE

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY. THIS DOCUMENT AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS:

By participating in the Brim Detroit Hat Bar experience, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agreed to the terms of this waiver.

1. Assumption of Risk: Participation in the Brim Detroit hat customization experience involves the use of crafting tools and equipment including, but not limited to:

- Hot press machines
- Hot glue guns
- Sewing needles and pins
- Scissors and cutting tools
- Adhesives and decorative materials

These tools may present risks including burns, cuts, punctures, or other injuries. Participants acknowledge these risks and voluntarily assume full responsibility for any injury or damage that may occur while participating in activities at Brim Detroit.

2. Burn Risk Notice: Participants acknowledge that hot press machines and hot glue guns operate at high temperatures and may cause burns if touched improperly. Participants agree to follow all safety instructions provided by Brim Detroit staff when using heated equipment.

3. Sharp Object Risk: Participants understand that sewing needles, scissors, and other sharp crafting tools may cause cuts or puncture injuries if used improperly. Participants agree to exercise caution and follow all safety guidance.

4. Release of Liability: In consideration for being permitted to participate in the Brim Detroit Hat Bar experience, the participant releases, waives, and discharges Brim Detroit, its owners, employees, contractors, and affiliates from any and all claims, liabilities, damages, or causes of action arising from participation in the activity, including claims resulting from negligence to the fullest extent permitted by Michigan law.

5. Personal Property: Participants are responsible for their own personal belongings. Brim Detroit is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property while on the premises.

6. Hat Customization & No Refund Policy: Once a hat has been customized, altered, glued, burned, sewn, or otherwise modified by the participant, the item is considered final. Brim Detroit is not responsible for mistakes made during customization, and refunds will not be issued for damaged or altered hats.

7. Alcohol Policy (Private Events Only): Guests attending approved private events at Brim Detroit may bring and consume their own wine. Hard liquor and other alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the premises. Individuals under the age of 21 are not allowed in the studio during any consumption of alcoholic beverages. All guests who choose to consume wine must be 21 years of age or older and may be required to present valid identification upon request.

Guests agree to drink responsibly while participating in studio activities. Due to the use of crafting tools, including heated equipment and sharp instruments, Brim Detroit reserves the right to refuse participation in crafting activities to any individual who appears intoxicated or whose behavior may create a safety concern.

Wine consumption is permitted only in designated areas during private events and must comply with all applicable local and state laws. Brim Detroit reserves the right to limit or prohibit alcohol consumption at any time to maintain a safe and comfortable environment for all participants.

Brim Detroit promotes responsible alcohol consumption and encourages guests to arrange safe transportation when attending events where alcohol is served.”

8. Compliance With Staff Instructions: Participants agree to follow all safety instructions provided by Brim Detroit staff. Failure to comply with safety rules may result in removal from the activity without a refund.

9. Photography & Media Release: Participants grant Brim Detroit permission to use photographs or video taken during the hat bar experience for marketing or promotional purposes unless written notice is provided declining consent.

10. Minors: Participants under the age of 18 may only participate with the permission of a parent or legal guardian. A parent or legal guardian must review and sign the required waiver prior to the minor's participation. By signing the waiver, the parent or legal guardian acknowledge and accepts full responsibility for the minor's conduct, safety, and actions while participating in activities at Brim Detroit and while using any tools, equipment, or materials provided by the business

11. Parent / Guardian Consent: I certify that I am the parent or legal guardian of the minor participant listed below and agree to all terms of this waiver on their behalf. I accept full responsibility for the minor's participation in the Brim Detroit hat bar activity.

12. Governing Law: This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Michigan. Any disputes shall be handled within the jurisdiction of Michigan courts.
